



**ECHOES – Extended Classroom for Higher Opportunities Enhancing Skills** - is a European project funded by the Erasmus+ Program under the Action Type KA220-VET - Cooperation partnerships in Vocational Education and training.

The project focus on two of the most significant recent development in VET: distance learning (methodologies, tools, and resources) and online digital learning.

The specific Objectives of the project are:

- to provide a comprehensive understanding on context, technologies, skills gaps, training needs in the field of online teaching, specifically addressing VET trainers, tutors, counsellors, curriculum planners and evaluators
- to improve digital skills and abilities of VET teachers, trainers and mentors engaged in distance learning processes by offering them freely accessible learning pathways to make efficient use of the platforms, tools and educational resources for creation of digital teaching contents or components
- to contribute to creation of learning pathways at local, regional and national levels for VET teachers, trainers and mentors engaged in distance learning processes, inspired to the relevant European Frameworks

These objectives will be achieved through implementation of the following expected project results and related activities:

**R1 - Research on the State of Art** on distance and virtual learning for VET and WBL projects.

**R2 - ECHOES Toolkit**, as a comprehensive catalogue of resources and materials tailored for VET projects in the three main fields of: training / training on the job; mentorship and accompaniment to job inclusion; business creation.

**R3 - ECHOES Pilot Training Course** for the empowerment of digital skills of teachers, trainers and mentors supporting online learning processes in VET and WBL systems

**R4 - ECHOES-OER**: an Open Educational Resource-OER based on the contents of the Toolkit and the Pilot Training Course.

## RESULT 2 - Toolkit

The ECHOES Toolkit is designed to support the implementation of online training interventions within Vocational Education and Training (VET) systems. The Toolkit contains a series of practical tools and methods tailored to the specific needs of trainers, mentors and, in general, VET practitioners.

The Toolkit is structured on the basis of the same thematic areas into which the "European Framework for the Digital Competence of Educators" (DigCompEdu) is organized, tailored to better serve the purposes of online training and further customized.

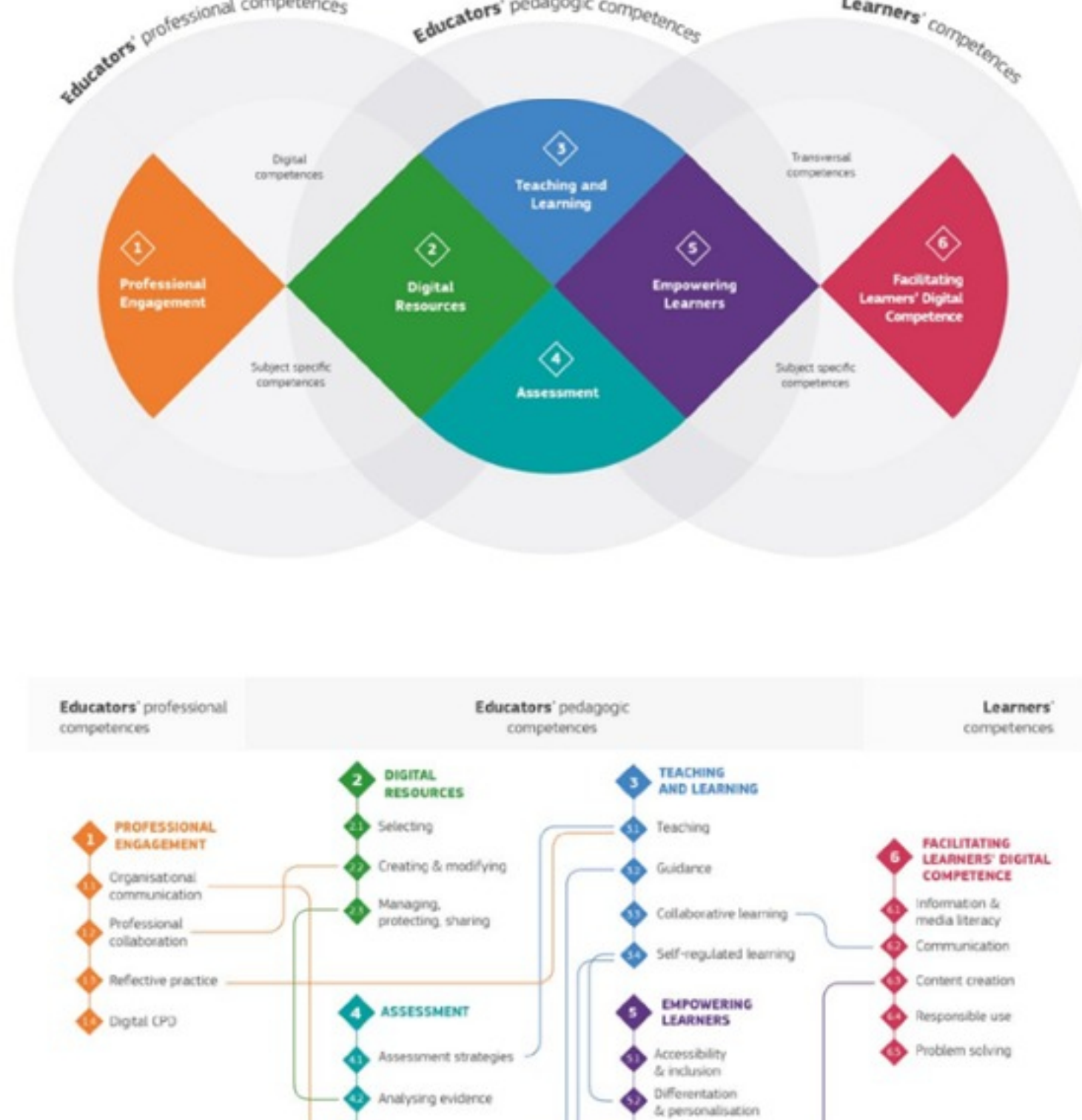

### DigCompEdu and the ECHOES Toolkit

The ECHOES Toolkit is structured on the basis of the Areas of Competence indicated in the European Digital Competence Framework (DigCompEdu).

Regarding the identification of skills and their declination in the areas of online learning and teaching, the following scheme describes their structure and location in the different areas of the DigCompEdu reference framework.



### Who are the users of the Toolkit?

Trainers, mentors and VET practitioners can have access, through the Toolkit, to methodologies and resources, available on the web and freely accessible (at least in the basic versions), in the following "Areas":

- **Training**
- **Work-based training**
- **Tutoring and support for job placement**
- **Support for self-entrepreneurship and business creation**

### How to use the Toolkit

To facilitate its use, the Toolkit is divided according to the following structure:

Areas: correspond to those of the Reference Framework (DigCompEdu), which are associated with the skills and abilities that will be enabled or strengthened through the use of the proposed Tools.

Sub-Areas: indicate, in each Area, the subsets of skills and abilities that will be enabled or strengthened through the use of the proposed Tools. Areas and Sub-Areas are consistent with the Reference Framework (DigCompEdu) and directly connect the skills and abilities involved with the individual Tools proposed.

Tools: Tools, among the various possible ones, proposed to VET professionals was made on the basis of specific research which brought out the most suitable ones to fill the skill gaps of the target levels (A2 and B1).

For the purposes of its usability, each Tool contains the following elements:

- Description of the Tool
- Pros and Cons
- How to access the Tool
- Purpose and degree of adequacy of the Tool with respect to the skills included in each Area and Sub-Area
- Degree of adequacy of the Tool with respect to the levels of previous knowledge/skills
- Tips and practical resources available for using the Tool
- Further information and readings
- Appropriateness of the Tool with respect to the implementation of specific tasks.

The Toolkit has been tested by 20 VET professionals/ WBL / Company Trainers / Mentor/ Business Creators, from each of the countries represented in the partnership (Austria, Italy, Slovenia, Spain), receiving excellent feedback in terms of RELEVANCE, EFFECTIVENESS, IMPACT, and SUSTAINABILITY.
